



## Roy M. Watkins

September 3, 1919 - June 5, 2010

Roy M. Watkins passed away peacefully Saturday, June 5, 2010 at Samaritan Hospital. Roy was born on September 3, 1919 in Lind, Washington to Robert L. and Mabel J. Watkins. He graduated from Lind High School. He married Edna Radach on January 18, 1942 at the Radach homestead south of Warden, WA. In the spring of 1943 they moved to Warden to begin farming and continued to farm until his retirement in 1984. He remained on the family farm until his recent death.

Roy was an active member of the Warden Community Church, served many years as an officer and member of the Warden Soil Conservation District and belonged to the Wannigan Trailer Club for over 25 years. He and his wife of 68 years traveled extensively. After their retirement they spent their winters in Yuma, AZ.

He is survived by his wife Edna; daughter Roylene (Dick) Scoggin, and son Roger (Paula) Watkins; 4 grandchildren, Tamra (Ken) Berg, Kori (Ken) Tjoelker, Kelly (Brent) Erdmann and Rett (Kim) Watkins; and 7 great grandchildren; 1 brother Walter, and 2 sisters, Roberta Bates and Geraldine Bradley.
