Sheila Mae Rosenberg, 17, a resident of Soap Lake, Wash. and a senior at Soap Lake High School, went to be with the Lord on Saturday, Feb. 19, 2011. She was born in Moses Lake, Wash. on August 17, 1993.

Sheila was a very loving little girl who always had a hug and bright shiny smile that she didn't hesitate to share with everyone. She had a passion for life which surrounded her mother, father, grandpa Vernon, grandma Goose, all of her friends and classmates, aunts, uncles and cousins.

Sheila attended grade school in Olympia before moving back to Soap Lake. She attended middle school in Soap Lake, then moved back to Olympia for the rest of her middle school education, and started her high school career at North Thurston High School. While in Olympia Sheila volunteered her time with various charities which she put her whole heart and soul into. Sheila and her mom moved back to Soap Lake where Sheila enrolled at Soap Lake High School.

She played the trumpet in middle school. She was a wonderful athlete – a member of the volleybal team and captain of the basketball team. She also excelled as a member of the track team. Sheila had a huge affection and respect for the elderly and children of all ages loved her.

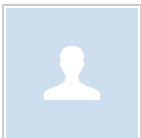
