



## Steven F. Hitchcock

May 19, 1931 - February 8, 2011

Steve F. Hitchcock passed away February 8, 2011 in Moses Lake, WA. Born May 19, 1931 in Prelate Saskatchewan, Canada, he moved to Moses Lake in the early 1950s.

Steve was an extremely hard worker and was appointed as the first ever Marshall for the newly incorporated Westlake, WA along with serving many other lead positions for that community. He spent most of his adult life farming in Block 89. He was a great friend and neighbor, committed foster parent, skilled pianist, and easy laugh.
