Thomas William Boyce, 57, longtime Moses Lake resident, passed away Friday, June 6, 2008 at Central Washington Hospital in Wenatchee, WA. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, June 11, 2008 at The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints Stake Center on Division Street in Moses Lake. Interment will follow in Sunset Memorial Gardens, Warden.
