March 1, 1915 - September 16, 2016

Tren Mitchell Jones passed away at his home on Friday, Sept 16, 2016 at the age of 101 in Moses Lake, WA. He was born March 1, 1915 in Cedar City, Utah. His parents were Alma Treharne and Sylvia Mitchell Jones. Tren was the oldest of five children. All of them preceded him in death except for his youngest brother, Alma. His siblings were Mary Mackelprang, Mitch Jones, Valois Jones and Alma Dell Jones. Tren married Margaret Christensen in the St. George Temple on Aug 28, 1940. Margaret preceded him in death on Dec 9, 2001.

Tren developed a logging business in Bonners Ferry ID. The family moved to Moses Lake where Tren operated a farm, always with the help of his sons and daughters. He owned a trucking business in Alaska and Moses Lake and Astro land development. Tren was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints and led a life of service.

Tren enjoyed missionary work and was blessed to go on a mission with his wife to Adam-Ondi-Ahman in 1991. Tren fulfilled a lifelong dream to fly when at 89 years old he got his pilot's license and built his own Ultralight Aircraft with his sons Tim and Kam. He was the oldest flight student in America at the time.
