Veda Bessie Griffiths Hadley, 86, Moses Lake, WA, passed away on June, 5, 2024 after sustaining a debilitating stroke.

Veda was born Tuesday, December 7th, 1937, the youngest of 10 children, to Andrew Heggie Griffiths and Adline Griffiths Godfrey at the family home in Clarkston Utah.

Veda graduated from North Cache High School in 1956 and went on to complete a 9-month Business course at Steven Hennigar School of Business. After receiving her college certificate, Veda worked numerous locations until accepting her mission call to the British Mission from January 9, 1961 to July 1962.
