Vincent T. Gundersen, 91, longtime Moses Lake resident, passed away Friday, July 24, 2009 at Samaritan Hospital. Graveside services will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, July 30, 2009 at Pioneer Memorial Gardens.

Vincent was born on August 23, 1917 in Claire City, South Dakota, son of the late Theodore and Mayme (Stapleton) Gundersen.
