



Yuri P. Tormozov

Yuri P. Tormozov, 71, longtime Ephrata resident, passed away Saturday, July 5, 2008 at Columbia Basin Hospital. A prayer service will be held on Tuesday evening, July 8, 2008 at 6:00 P.M. at Kayser's Chapel of Memories. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M. Wednesday, July 9, 2008 at the Church In Moses Lake, 6378 Arnold Drive, Moses Lake with Pastor Peter Fendich officiating.
